- Support affordable housing organizations and programs
- Provide home-buying assistance for employees
- Advocate for land use policies that prioritize equitable investment of resources for residents in New Orleans
- Leverage free, flexible, or unused space for community benefit
- Provide a Savings or Retirement account match
- Provide educational resources about home-buying assistance programs to all employees
- Provide educational resources for financial literacy to employees through trainings, class or workshop assistance



- Provide paid professional development opportunities through trainings, certifications, and other resources
- Offer pathways of professional development for all employees
- Participate in community apprenticeships or other workforce development programs
- Support organizations that promote educational services
- Offer internship programs (paid or for academic credit)
- Partner with youth educational programs
- Provide flexibility for parents who need to pick up their children from school or other programs





- Implement an Energy Efficiency policy
- Participate in the Energy Smart Program or other energy assessment program
- Educate and train your team on your energy efficiency strategies
- Support organizations that advocate for energy efficiency, accessible energy, and/or renewable energy
- Track and assess energy and water consumption
- Utilize renewable energy
- Track and report energy savings
- Support community opportunities for accessible renewable energy



Health

- Offer onsite healthcare access or healthcare programs
- Offer paid health insurance to employees (or stipend for smaller organizations)
- Offer retirement plans to employees
- Offer short-term and long-term disability insurance
- Provide paid family leave
- Support organizations that promote healthy living
- Provide paid maternity and paternity leave for full time employees
- Offer gym, yoga, mental health services, or other alternative health benefits





- Support organizations that promote Equity
- Implement a policy to support Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) owned suppliers
- Implement an anti-racism and inclusivity policy
- Support employees in workforce development programs by providing resources, flexible work arrangements, compensation for professional development, etc.
- Offer living wages to all employees
- Facilitate or participate in an annual employee anti-racism or inclusivity training
- Track and share Supplier Diversity spending
- Accommodate childcare for employees
- Attend equity educational workshops
- Ban the Box during hiring
- Create internal system for workplace bias reporting (inclusive of employer follow up)
- Develop and Implement a pronoun policy
- Guarantee weekly minimum for hourly employees
- Offer internal support to combat language barriers at the workplace
- Provide gender inclusive facilities on property
- Provide opportunities for Cross Training
- Provide salary ranges and transparency during hiring
- Take an equity audit or Index



Local Culture

- Implement a policy to favor local artists, designers, and musicians
- Implement a policy to support locally-owned businesses
- Support organizations that advocate for local culture
- Track and share spending on local vendors





- Donate leftover food items
- Support organizations and programs that promote local food production
- Track and share company spending on local food suppliers
- Implement a policy to support locally-owned suppliers



Transportation

- Install bike racks or offer indoor bike storage at your facility
- Install Electric Vehicle (EV) power station(s) at your business location
- Offer flexible work arrangements for your employees, as applicable
- Offer health insurance cost savings for using alternative transportation
- Provide navigation support for alternative modes of transportation to your workplace
- Support organizations and programs that promote alternative modes of transportation
- Incentivize biking/public transit by offering stipends
- Provide commuter benefits
- Provide safety materials for commuters biking or walking
- Create a policy to prioritize ground transportation over air for business travel where possible





- Adopt a catch basin
- Engage in a stormwater assessment
- Install low-flow water fixtures
- Implement Green Stormwater Infrastructure
- Promote water conservation through employee education and engagement
- Recycle FOG (Fats, oils, and grease)
- Support organizations that help prevent flooding through green infrastructure, manage water wisely, and / or organizations that help restore the coast through donations and volunteering.
- Facilitate or host a community conversation on stormwater education
- Provide educational resources to employees about coastal restoration projects in Louisiana
- Recycle items that also contribute to coastal restoration (glass, Christmas trees, etc.)



Zero Waste

- Compost food scraps and other organic materials
- Donate leftover food, materials, and resources
- Conduct an annual waste stream assessment
- Implement a Zero Waste policy or goal
- Implement company-wide recycling for metal, cardboard, paper and other relevant materials
- Promote waste reduction strategies with staff and customers by providing signage, trainings, competitions, and/or rewards
- Update SOPs and training events for staff on waste reduction strategies
- Track and report waste diversion rates
- Support organizations that promote Waste Reduction
